ATREYA

Canteen vendor takes a plate and gives him 2 idly's dipped in sambhar. Atreya waits few seconds.

ATREYA

Chutney?

CANTEEN VENDOR

You asked sambhar dip

ATREYA

So you will not give chutney?

CANTEEN VENDOR

ATREYA

CANTEEN VENDOR

ATREYA

CANTEEN VENDOR

Atreya takes his plate and goes to his table.

2 INT. A CLASSROOM - MORNING (INTERIOR LIGHTING)

Atreya standing in front of a class filled with students. He has a small gas cylinder, a hammer and a matchbox on the table and "Entropy" written on the board.

ATREYA

Entropy, The measure of disorder, chaos.

Atreya points to the gas cylinder.

ATREYA

What is this?

STUDENTS (NOT IN SYNC)

Gas Cylinder.

ATREYA

Right, a cylinder filled with gas. Now what does the gas consist of?

MAYA

Molecules sir.

ATREYA

Very good Maya! Now there is a specific number of possible ways these molecules can arrange themselves inside this confined space hence it has a purpose. It can help you cook your food, warm your water etc. This state it is in now is called low entropy. Now if I take this hammer and smack it till it starts leaking, what happens?

Silence in the class.

ATREYA

The gas comes out and starts to spread in the classroom. Now the number of possible ways these gas molecules can arrange themselves inside this big room, increases. CUT TO:

HOST

The winner of this years debate competition is Gautam.

Gautam comes on stage to receive the trophy with sound of applause taking over.

FADE TO:

4 EXT. UNIVERSITY PARK - MORNING

Atreya walking in the park as Gautam crosses him jogging and turns around

GAUTAM

Hi, I thought you were great yesterday.

Atreya keeps on walking and Gautam starts to walk with him.

ATREYA

If I was that great I would have won.

GAUTAM

Still bitter huh?

As Gautam was talking he stepped on a plant.

ATREYA

Watch out!

Atreya goes to fix the plant.

ATREYA

Plants have life, you shouldn't walk over them. I am sure you know that don't you?

GAUTAM (WITH A SMIRK)

Well if they do have life they
should be able to defend
themselves.

With that Gautam starts jogging while Atreya is looking at
him jogging away.
